Overview

Overview

Here are some key points & advantages of using this new tool in POS UX:

- ❖ You can customize and adapt your F&B menus to your liking, with dishes corresponding to starters, main courses, desserts, etc.,
- Easy and quick configuration in TMS by the user.
- User friendly & very intuitive to use in POS UX.
- ❖ You can charge for example the Daily Menu with its price and add products at €0 or with a price supplement if applicable.
- ❖ You can continue sending kitchen order ticket and fire the dish as usual.



The transactions used in TMS to create the menu in POS UX are the following ones:



To create a new menu or customize an existing one.




/CCSHT/POS_MN_MGMT - Menu Management

Customize an existing menu from the list.




To <u>create a new menu</u>, follow these steps:

1. Go to /CCSHT/POS_MN_LIST and choose your hotel:



2. Click on «Create menu»




3. Complete the **Data tab** with the corresponding information (*points 1 & 2 are always the same data).




- 1. A GENERAL
- 2. 00017
- Material number of the Menu
- 4. Choose if the menu is open or closed
- 5. Number of dishes that make up the menu.
- 6. Valid dates + "Disabled" option
- 7. Days of the week when the menu is active

4. Complete the <u>Item tab</u> by extending the materials and choosing their corresponding Kitchen Group.




- A) General material's database where you can extend the material you are using in your menu. The material that you extend must be exist in your outlet's database.
- **B)** Choose the kitchen Group (Starter, First, Dessert...) to configure it in POS UX. If you want to have the same material in different kitchen groups, extend it again with the corresponding one.
- C) All the materials that make up the menu and the corresponding kitchen group you have selected.


5. Complete the **Dishes Group** tab.




- Qty Items: Number of dishes that make up the corresponding Kitchen Group (Starter, First, Dessert). Please note that if it is set to 2 and you want to load 3 dishes into this Kitchen group in POS UX, you will have exceeded the limit and will not be able to charge that product.
- Order: in what order the kitchen groups will appear visually in POS UX.

6. Open a <u>Jira</u> requesting the activation of the menus in POS UX to complete the entire configuration.





The **prices** of the menu will be managed through the Price levels transaction: /CCSHT/POS_PRICE_LEV - Price levels




*Apply a price supplement




If you need to add a price supplement to a product that you have configured in the menu, add the price in the "supplement" column so that it is added in POS UX.



Once all the configuration is done in TMS with the menu, you can proceed to start using it in POS UX.









A visual mask will appear and when you hit the exclamation mark in the type of Kitchen Group, the corresponding dishes will be available.











The menu will appear with its price and below it will be a breakdown of all the selected dishes (only for the kitchen order ticket).


Once you have added all the dishes, click on the "Back" button.




In case you want to edit anything, swipe and use the "Modify Line" option to open again the mask and the menu.




You can still editing & deleting products.




Or add more products by clicking the "Kitchen group" button and selecting the dish.




If you are managing more tan 1 menu, you will need to type the cover when choosing their dishes.



For example, menú x3 people. In this way, it will displayed with their corresponding selection.





"Move Between Menus" button, will allow you to change the position of the cover/menu.



In the previous example, we have moved the "Scallops" (1) to Cover/menu (2), therefore the change will be applied in the ticket.

If you have applied any **price supplements** to specific materials, these will be added to the total ticket price.
