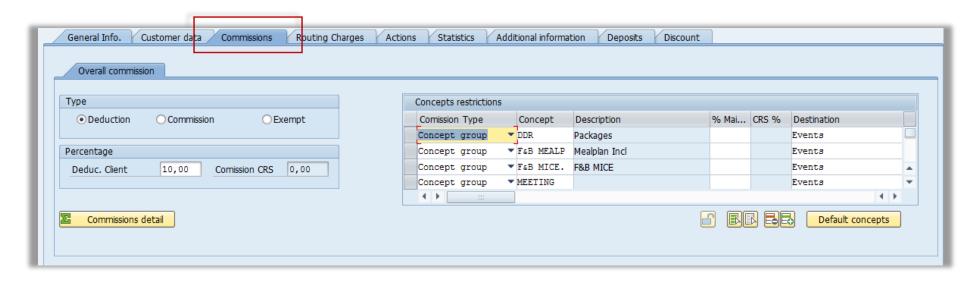

Tab that allows management of the commissions of the reservations belonging to the booking file.



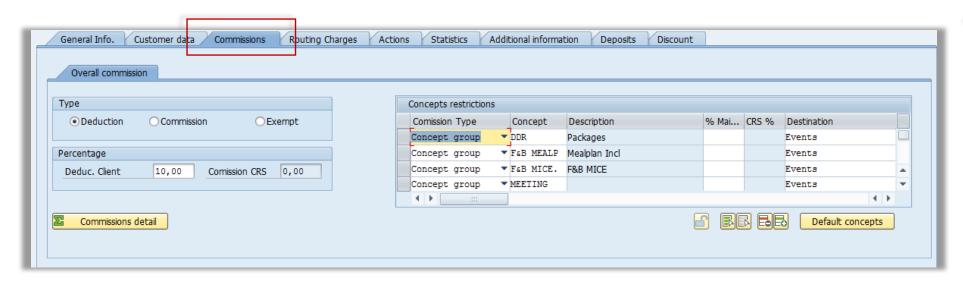
See Corporate commission Policy to know all the details of %, commissionable services and exceptions.

Commission percentage will be normally 10%, although it could exceptionally be raised up to 15%. In case of more commission is granted additional approvals are needed:

Commission rate	Responsible person
=< 10%	GEM – GGT Agent/Hotel
10% - 15%	Segment Leader / BU Commercial Director
> 15%	VP Corporate Sales / VP Distribution



If you book from Call Center, you will have already charged this information.

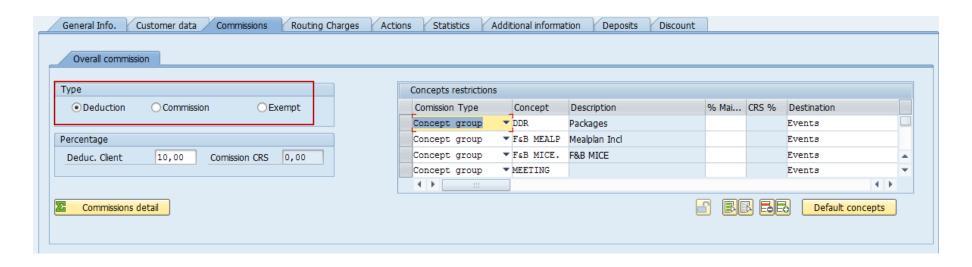




- Commission percentage and type (deduction or commission) will be charged according to the customer's profile in CRM.
- All concepts will be automatically charged in "concepts restrictions" too.
- This information is transferred to the event and convention group.



STEP 1: select the correct type of commission



If you have any question about commission percentage and type applied. Go customer's profile in $CRM \rightarrow Tab$ "Hotel parameter" (exceptionally it may be changed if there is a different negotiation).

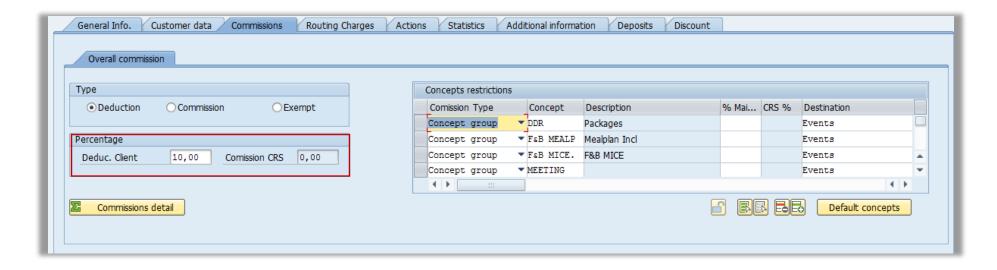
• Deduction: discounted on the invoice

Commission: expected commissions

• Exempt: no commission



STEP 2: enter the overall commission %



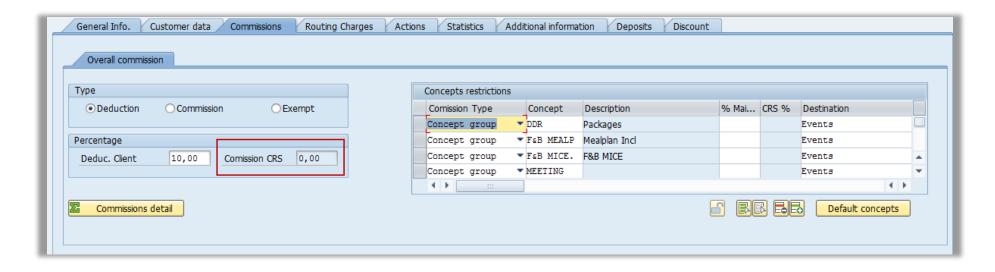
Commission Client: the % of commission informed in this tab will apply to the Main Customer.

In TMS we are allowed to calculate commission for every type of customers, Travel Agencies or Companies and self employees (that's mean Event planners, OPC, etc.).





STEP 2: enter the overall commission %



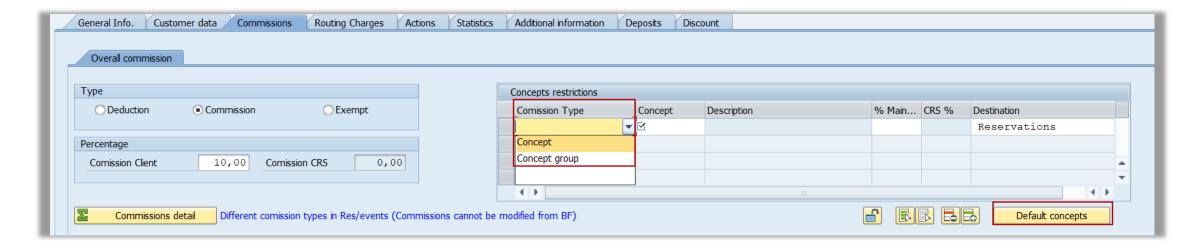
Commission CRS: on some occasions the Main Customer hires the services through a third partner, requesting commission as well. In case of a commission requested by a CRS billing deduction will never apply. (OPC, Event planner, etc.).

To be able to inform Commission CRS, the CRS must be completed in tab customer data (in this example is not informed and for this reason is shadowed).

If we inform the commission here, it will be charged properly in ONYX as for main client as for CRS customer.



STEP 3: define the commissionable concepts



Three options to inform the commissionable concepts:

• Concept: manually select a concept.

• Concept group: concepts part of the group are activated within the commissions tab of the event and/or convention group.

• Default concepts: list of concepts for which it is possible to add/delete.

The commissionable concepts are uploaded by default, just in case you miss anyone, you will need to add it manually.

No concept entered = no commission applied.



By uploading a concept group, you will activate several concepts within the commission tab of the event and/or the convention group.

Five concept groups are created:

Special importance for countries that apply multiple types of VAT for Beverage services.

Be aware to include the proper concept manually in case your list is not updated.

Later, open a ticket Jira to add them in the list, and save time in future MBs.



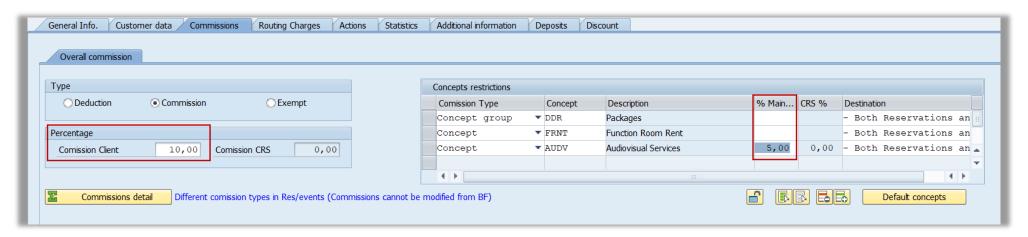
Management of different % of commission



If a concept or a group of concepts have been contracted for another % than the overall commission, you need to enter the % in the box of concepts restrictions. The concepts for which the overall commission % applies, should remain empty.

Example

- 10% function room and DDR concept group*
- 5% audio-visual



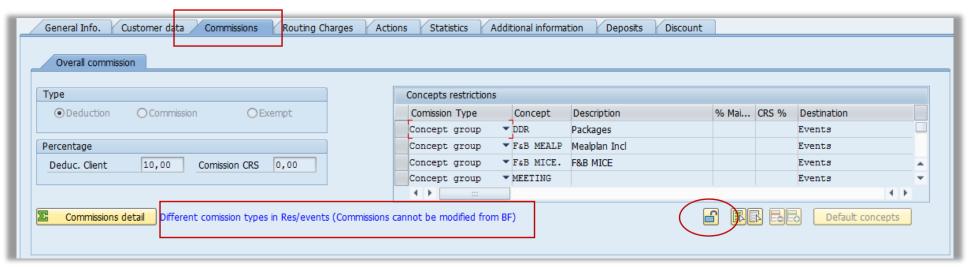

Inform commission via booking file: the data is transferred to the event and convention group

- Within the event we find the event concepts, excluding convention group concepts.
- Within the convention group we find all concepts.
- If you select a concept group, all concepts related to the event are activated within the tab commission of the event and all the room concepts are activated within the tab commission of the convention group.

If we modify anything in the event or convention group, we will see this warning in the BF

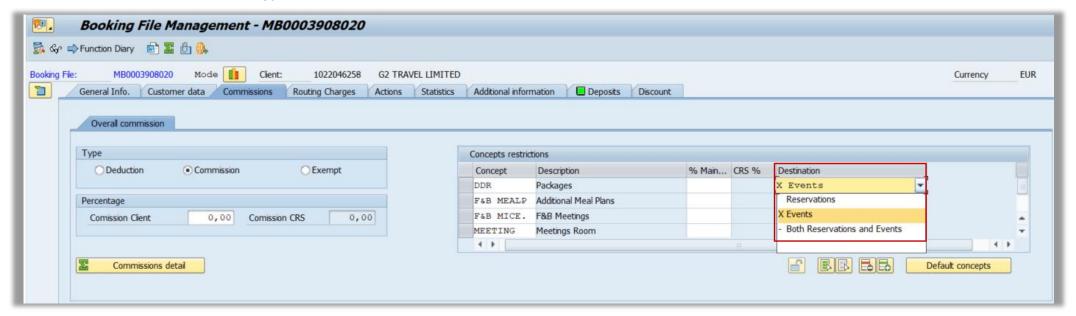




Inform commission via booking file: "destination"

When you inform a a concept or concept group, you can define where the commission is applied,:

- Convention
- Event
- Both





Most the commissionable charges are uploaded by default, use this option just for specific situations and open a Ticket jira to request the charge by default.





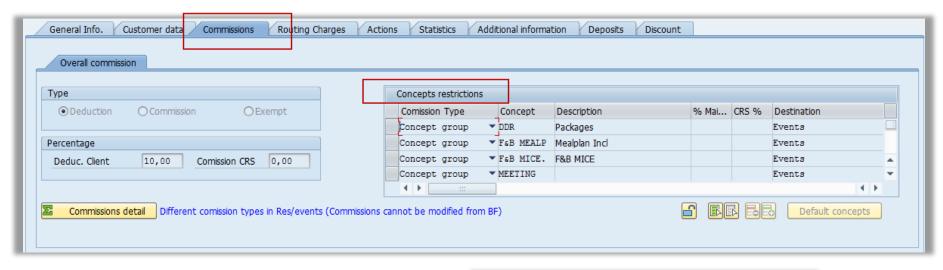

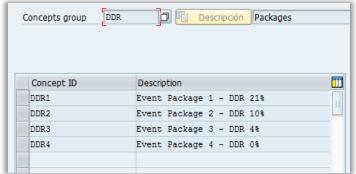


Commission on concepts part of a DDR package can be activated selecting "DDR" concept group too.

Example: 10 % commission for DDR (Netherlands, multiple types of VAT %).

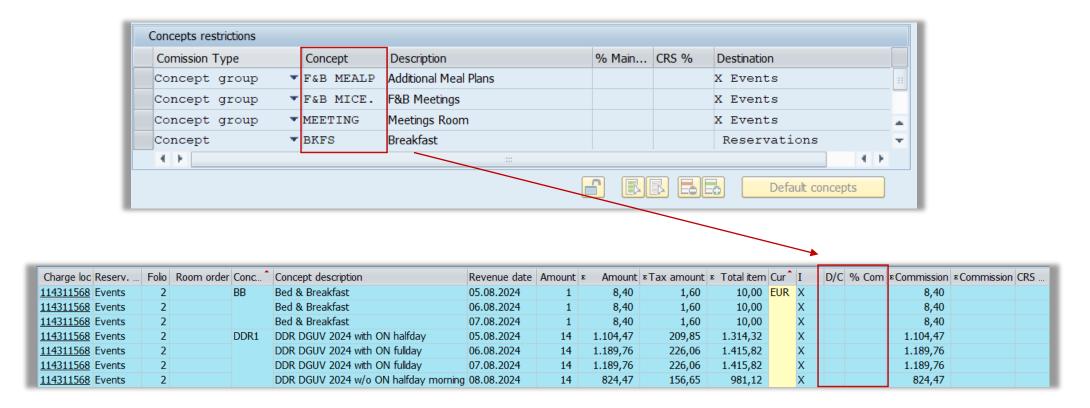




No commission for DDR's if you do not enter the concept(s) DDR.



Example: concept(s) DDR is not included, so no commission is applied.

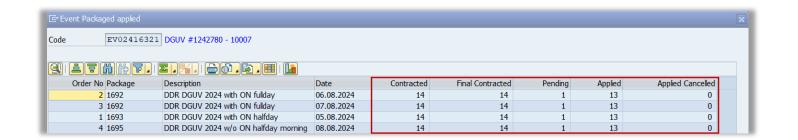


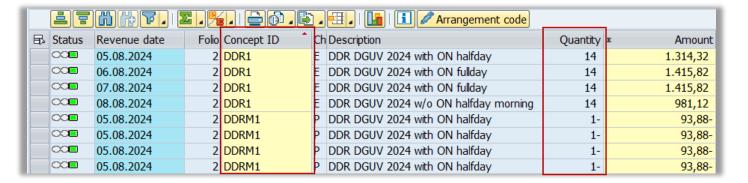
When you apply a package in a breakdowns, TMS includes the concept "DDRM" in the folios. . It is a billing concept.

Countries that apply multiple VAT % for MICE, should always select multiple DDRM concepts when they want to apply commission on DDR packages which are to be "applied".

DDRM1/DDRM2/DDRM3/DDRM4 - the concept includes all concepts part of the DDR with a specific VAT %. The concept commissionable is DDR never DDRM.

- DDR = revenue concept
- DDRM = billing concept





When applied packages are to be paid directly by the guest ("POA") the commission type should be "commission". If you select the type "deduction", the deducted commission is applied on the direct payment reservations.

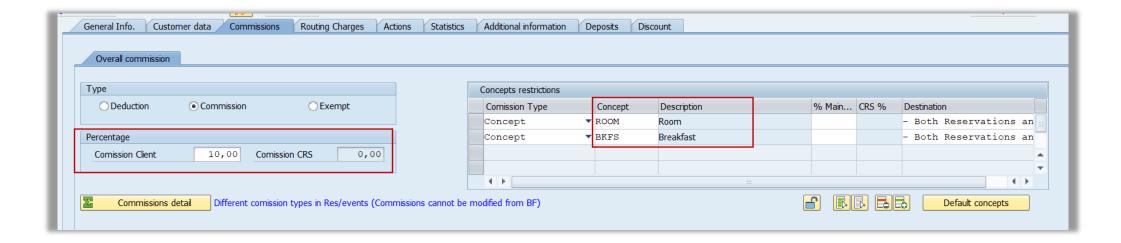

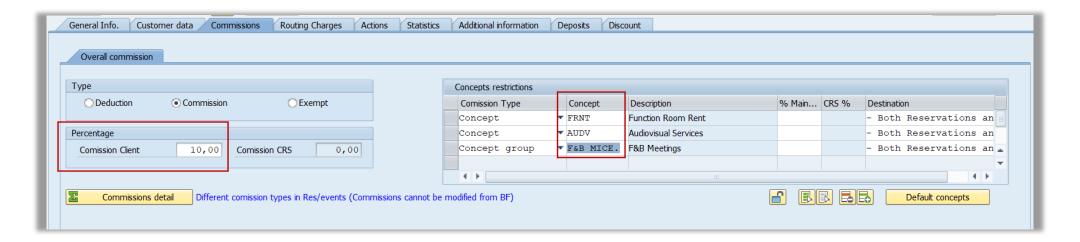

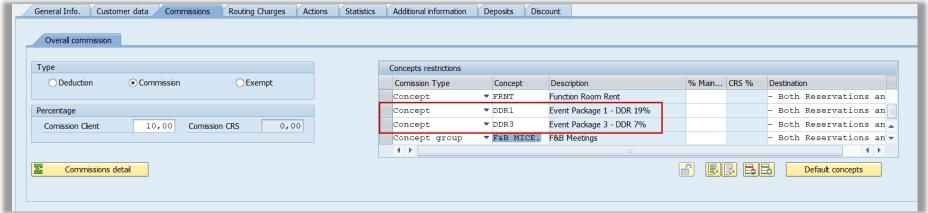

10% commission client DDR (Germany, multiple types of VAT %)
10% commission client function room, F&B MICE outside of DDR package

- Concept DDR1 Event Package 1 = DDR (high VAT concepts)
- Concept DDR2 Event Package 2 = DDR (low VAT concepts)
- Concept FRNT = Function room rental outside of DDR package
- Concept group F&B MICE* = F&B outside of DDR package

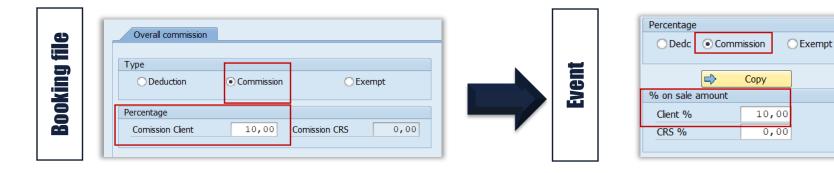

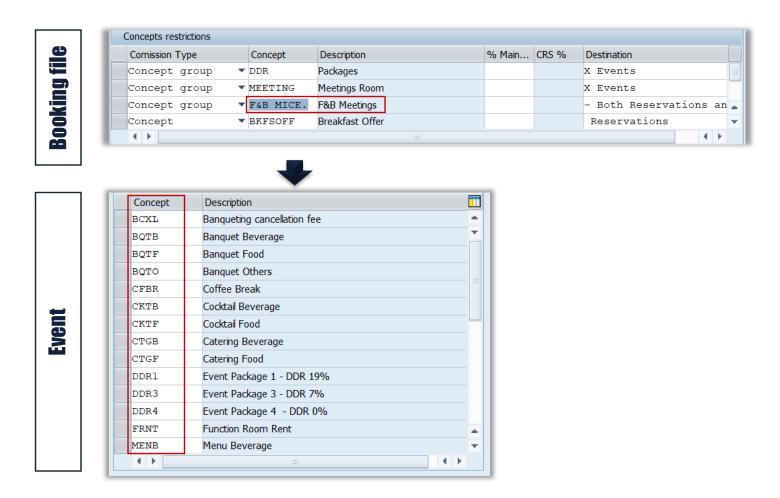
Overall commission entered within the booking file is transferred to the commission tab within the event

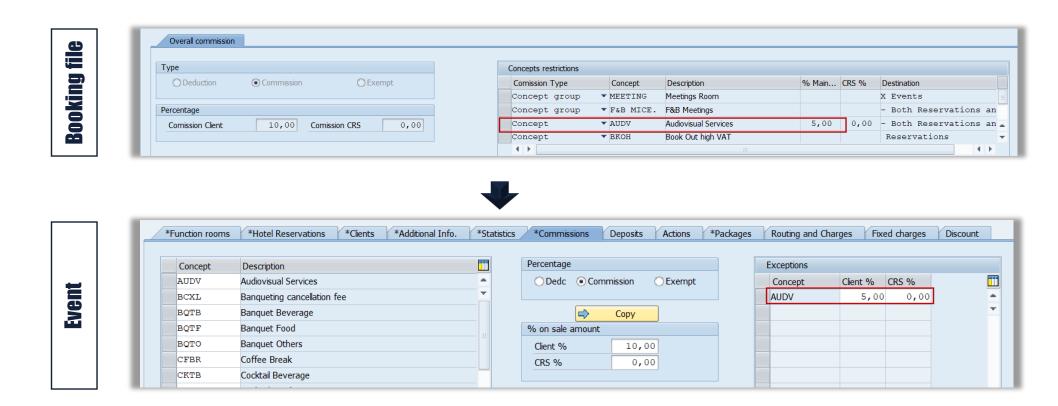
Commissionable concepts are part of a concept group entered within the booking file. They are transferred to the commission tab within the event (event concepts only, in below example the concept Room is transferred to the convention group)

Different % of commission entered within the booking file are transferred to the commission tab within the event.



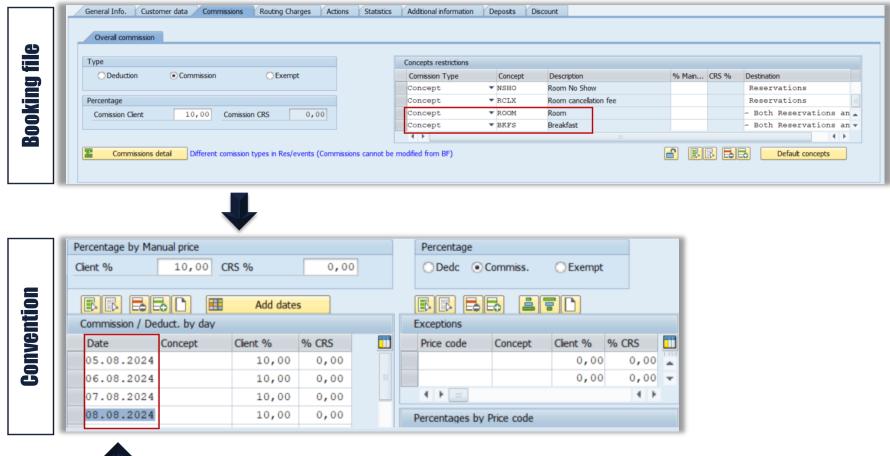


BOOKING FILE \rightarrow CONVENTION the result within the convention

Overall commission entered within the booking file is transferred to the *prices and commission tab* within the convention group.



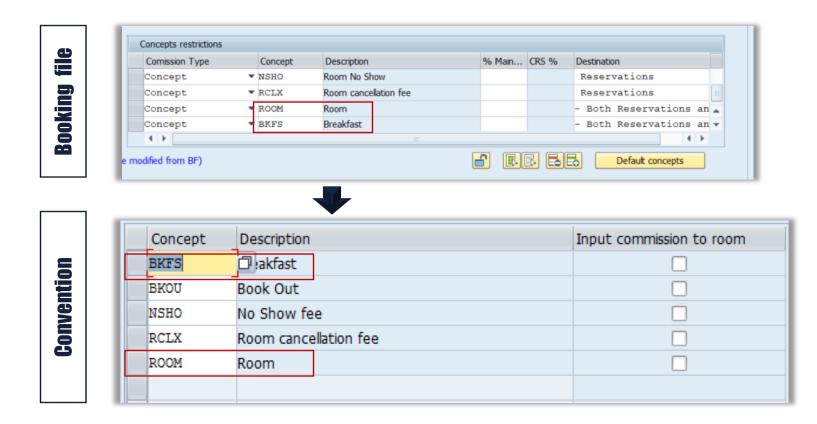


Date is automatically entered

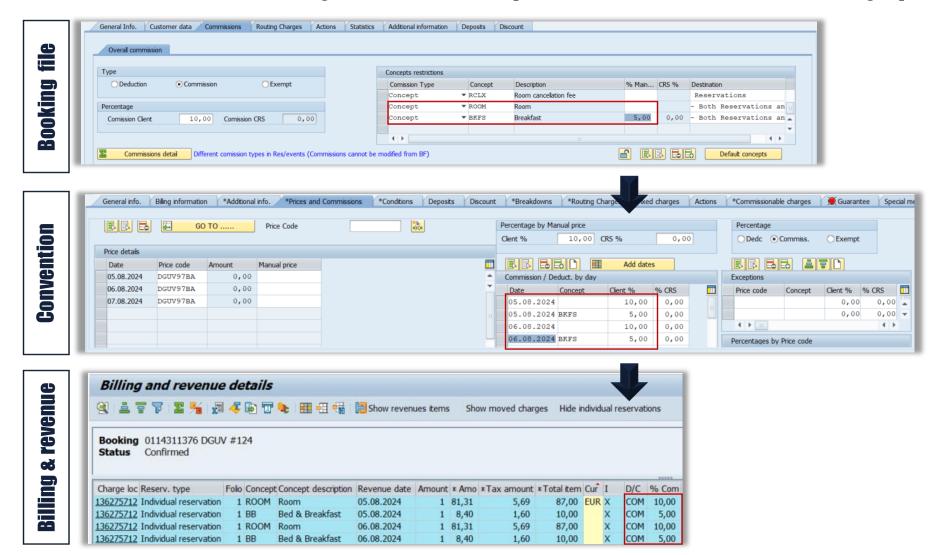
Commissionable concepts or part of a concept group entered within the booking file are transferred to the commissionable charges tab within the convention group.

Different % of commission entered within the booking file are transferred to the prices and commission tab within the convention group.

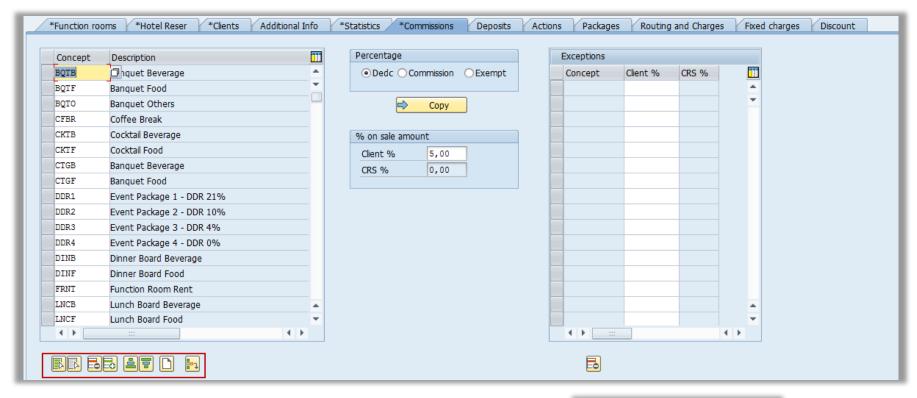




COMMISSION MANAGEMENT via event and convention group



Within the event you can add or delete concepts



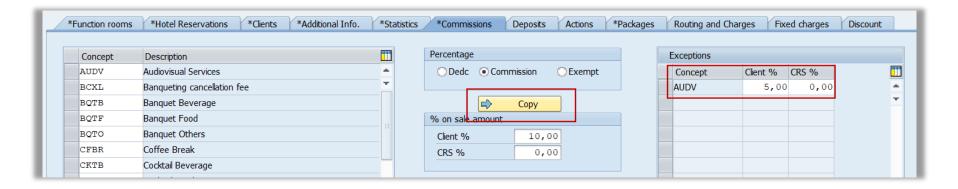
- To add a concept, select a concept from the drop-down list
- To delete a concept
- To bring all the concepts of the event





To apply another commission %

- Select the concept
- Press Copy
- Add the commission % in the box of exceptions





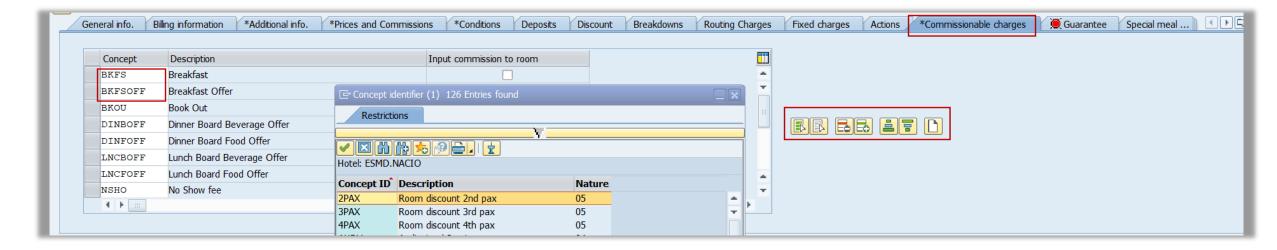
- Select the exception and press to delete the exception, the concept will remain in the commissionable concepts for which the overall commission % would still apply.
- Don't add room and breakfast in this tab. Just when you must inform manual charges.

Concepts added on event level are not transferred to the booking file and convention group.



Within the convention group you can add or delete concepts in the tab commissionable charges. Although the most used are uploaded automatically.

To add a concept, select a concept from the drop-down list.



To delete a concept, if applicable deletes the concept from the tab prices and commission.



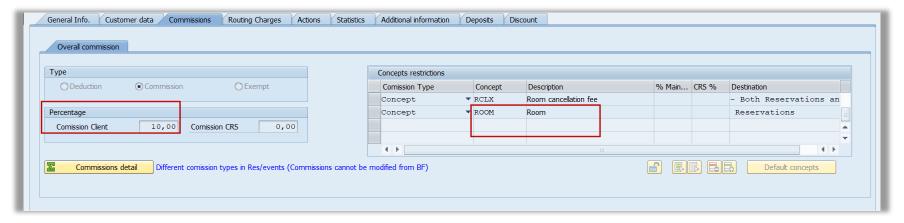
The added concepts apply same rules according to set up in tab *prices and commission*.



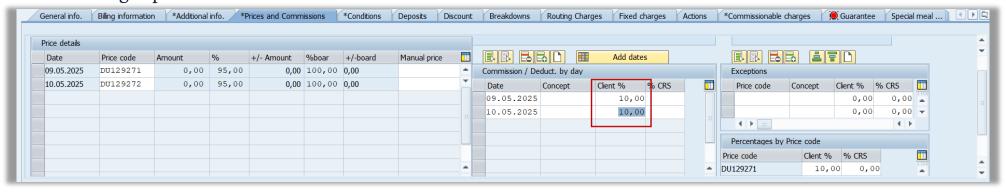
If other rules apply you need to manage 2 steps

- 1. complete the tab commissionable charges
- 2. complete in tab prices and commissions the commission/deduct. by day

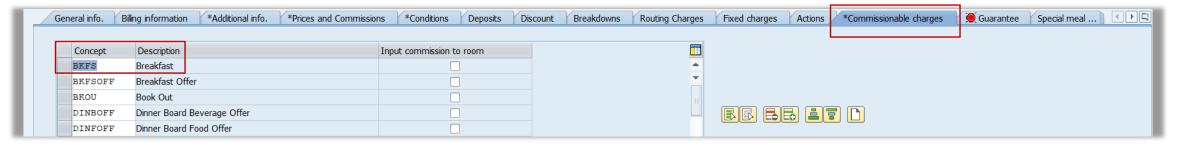

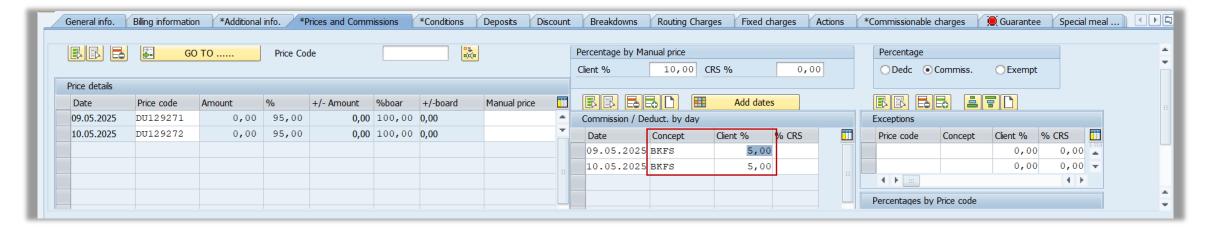


Breakfast is commissionable for 5%

Step 2: open tab "prices and commission": add the date, concept and %



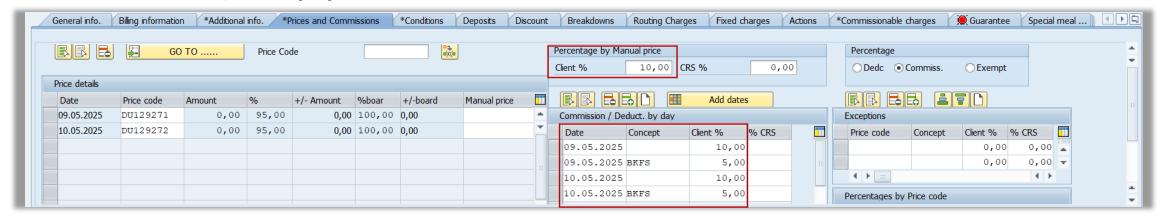

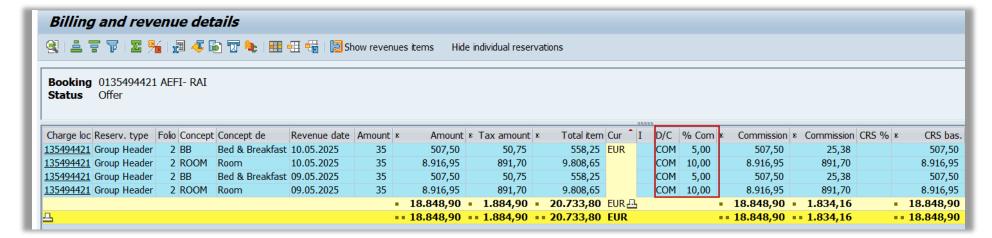


The Percentage by Manual price is by default completed as the % in the booking file was only 10%, no exceptions.

Please note, that the Commission/Deduct. by day will overrule



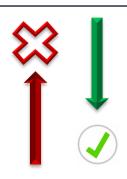

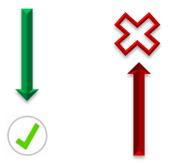

- Modifications managed on event level are not updated within the booking file.
- Modifications managed on event level do not transfer to the convention group.
- Modifications applied in the commissions tab within the booking file will overwrite modifications previously managed directly in the event.

CONVENTION GROUP

- Modifications managed within the convention group are not updated within the booking file.
- Modifications managed within the convention group do not transfer to the event.
- Modifications applied in the commissions tab within the booking file will overwrite modifications previously managed directly in the convention group.



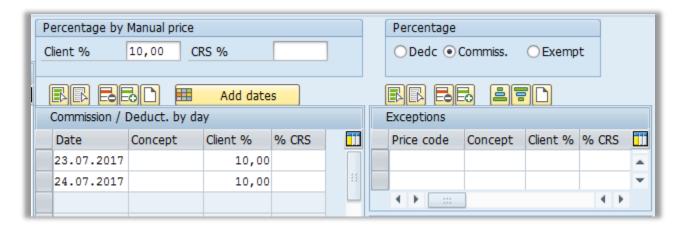


COMMISSION MANAGEMENT VIA CONVENTION GROUP

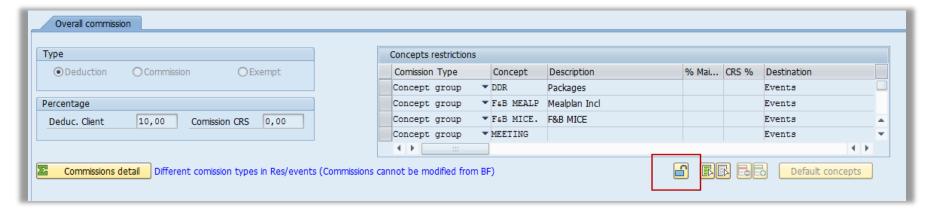


Within the event and the convention group you can change the type of commission. The fields are open for modification of the type. Once a different type of commission has been selected you can modify by clicking here via the booking file.

Example: within convention group type "commission" is activated.



Different type "Deduction" in the booking file, as a result the commission tab can be managed and modified via the booking file.

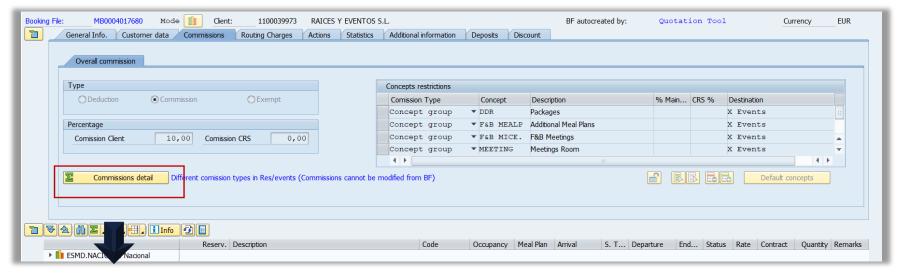


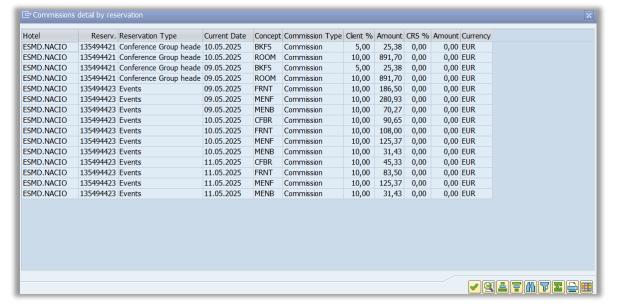




Do the concepts have revenue? You can review within the booking file the commissions detail

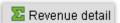
Note: if no revenue is booked on the concepts informed as commissionable, these are excluded from the commissions detail.



Within the event you can check the event revenue (event billing and production detail)

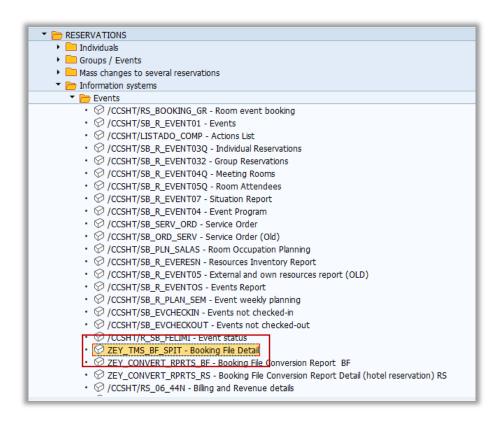


KEY POINT!

Check all the commission information before the first Night Audit, the key in the process is review the reservations in advance and try to detect any error!

Also, you can check future MICE Reservations through TMS4M in ZEY_TMS_BF_SPIT-Booking File Detail

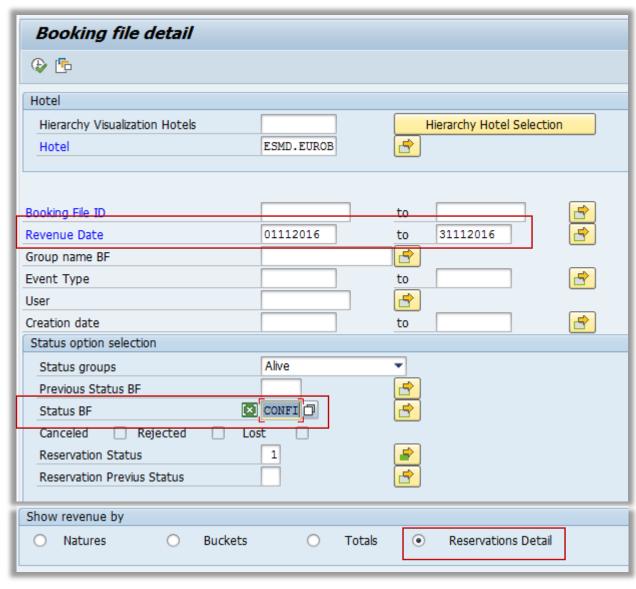
The review of the reservations will allow you tight the control within the commission control process, ensuring the provision of commissions are informed in TMS. Focus your attention on MICE Reservations done by any kind of intermediary, commissions management is a key point to get back new business

You can filter by different criteria to review On the book's reservations:

- BF ID
- Revenue Date
- BF Status



Click on reservation details to get reservation number in the report



The main points of the report to consider are:

- The information is grouped by Nature: Extras (incl. Function rooms, Equipment, etc.), F&B (incl. Banqueting services and F&B services), Room (room reservations included in the Group reservations)
- Commission or Discount (deduction) applied in the reservation is shown as amount (no % is shown). Review MICE reservations with commission = o
- You can navigate for display de reservation. From here no modifications are allowed.



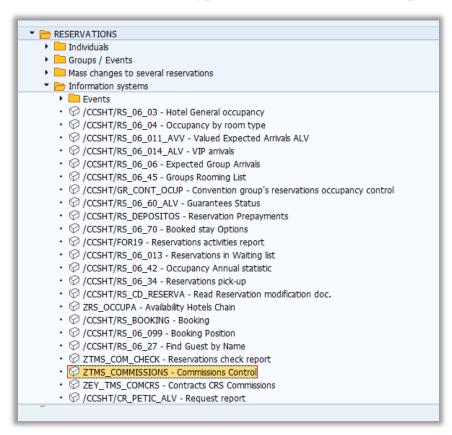


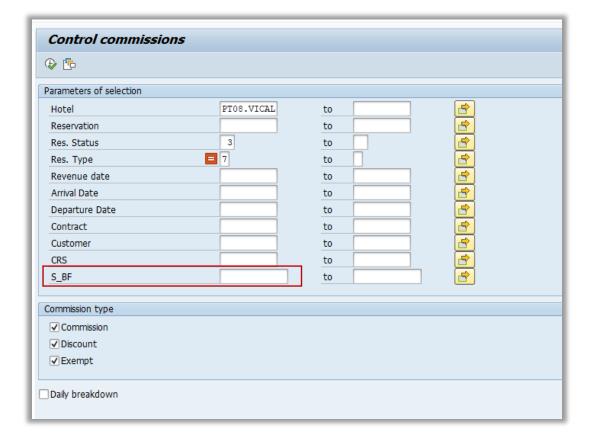
A commission also can be negotiated with a Company, self employee, etc. (Event planners, Congress organizers, etc.) inform the commission level for these partners in the system.



As the review of the individual reservations, you can performance this task using the Reservations \rightarrow Information Systems \rightarrow report ZTMS_COMMISSIONS, to review MICE Reservations.

You can select as Reservation type: Events, Convention Groups, Group Header, etc. by booking file number is the field called S_BF







ZTMS COMMISSIONS

You can navigate to review de MICE Reservation; no modifications are allowed from here. Pay special attention to:

- ✓ Reservations from partners which could request commission
- ✓ Different type of commissions in the same BF (could be a mistake)
- ✓ Commission amount = 0







BOOKING FILE

Modifications applied in the commissions tab within the booking file will overwrite modifications previously managed directly in the broken-down reservation not checked in.

CONVENTION GROUP

Modifications applied in the commissions tab within the convention group: a pop up will appear with option to apply to the broken-down reservation not checked in.

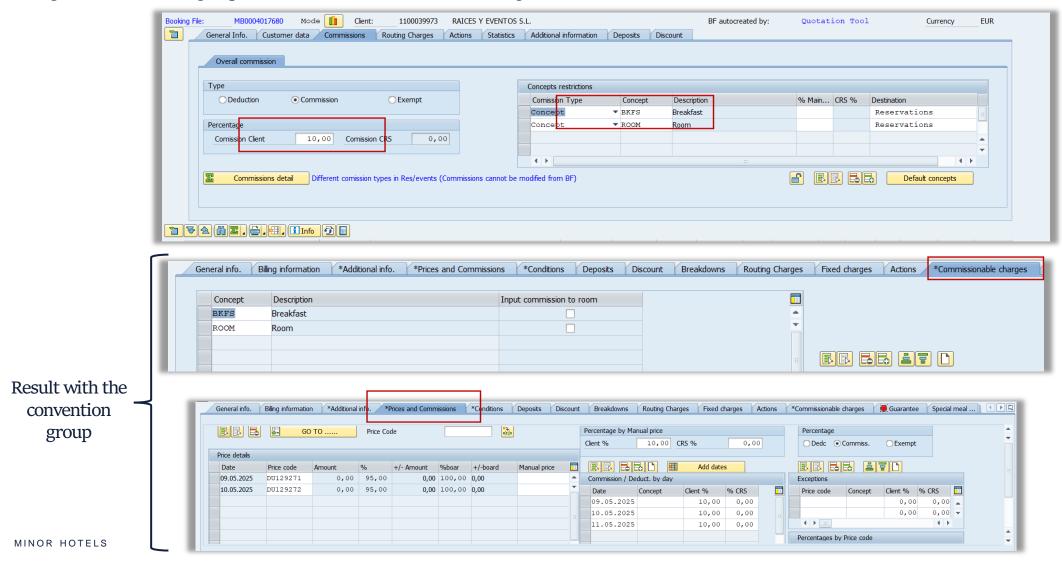


Modifications managed within the broken-down reservation are not updated within the convention group and booking file.

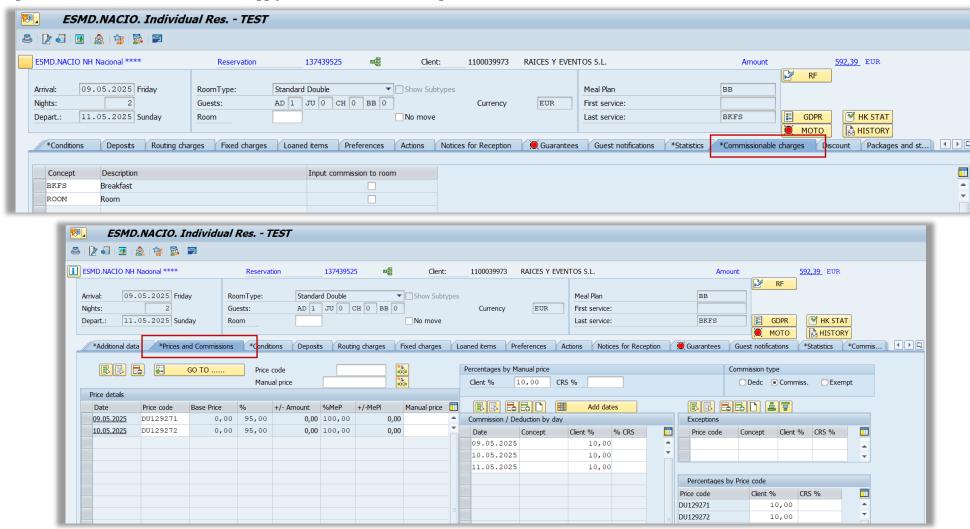

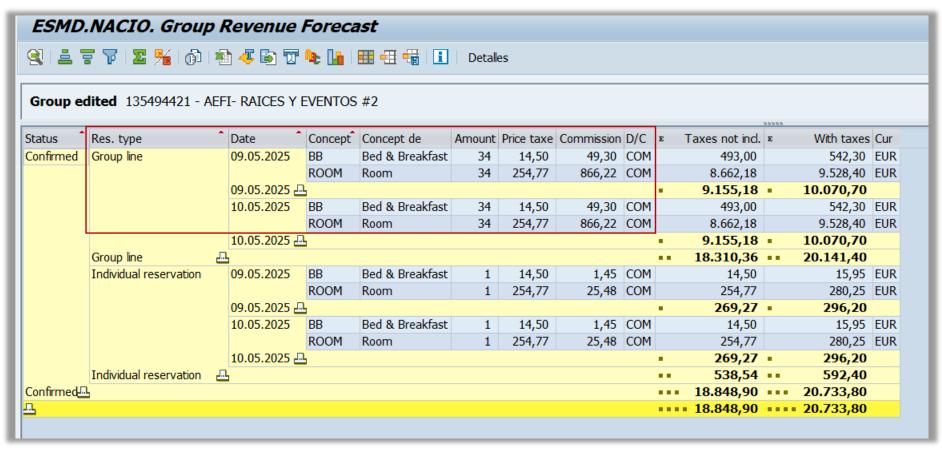
If you flag the option "in put commission to room", TMS won't apply commission in this concept.

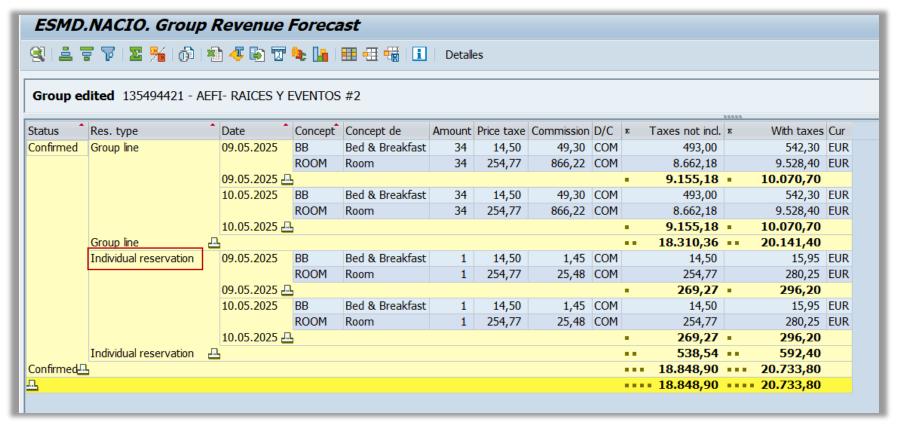

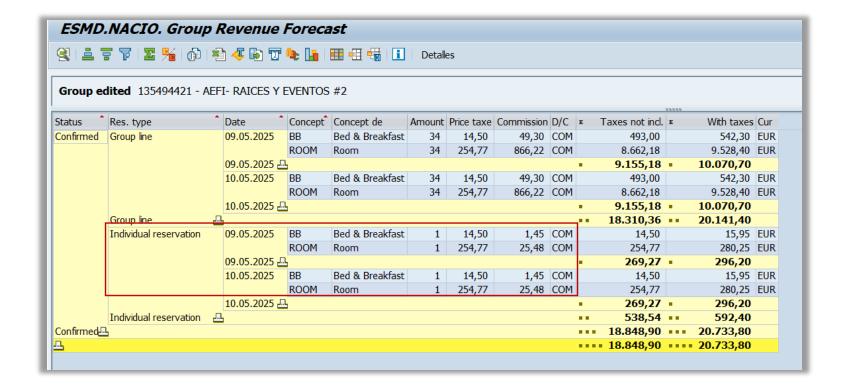

If the type is "deduction" and the commissionable concepts are "POA" (direct payment by the individual guest) the type should be modified to "commission" to avoid the deducted commission is applied on the direct payment reservations.

Example of a reservation paid by the guest directly and for which the type has not been changed to "commission" \rightarrow as a result the guest receives the deducted commission

- 10% deducted room & breakfast
- Routing charges: room + BB = individual
- 1 room broken down
- 34 rooms pending

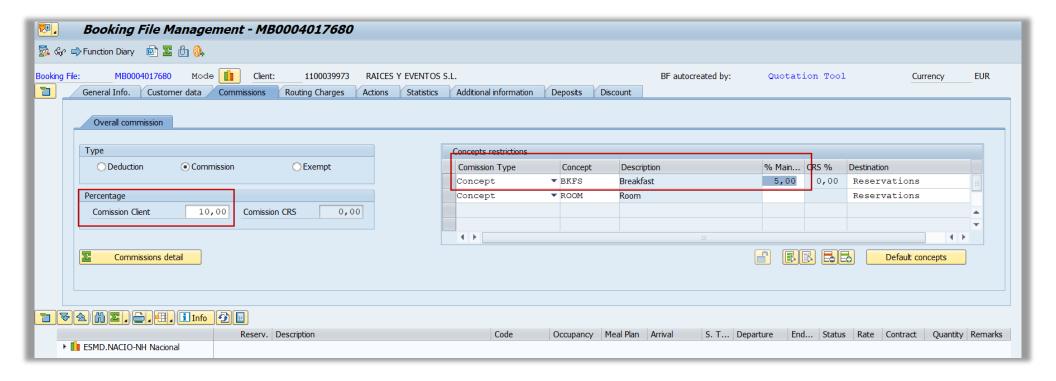




Example of a broken-down reservation part of a booking file for which different % of commission is applied.

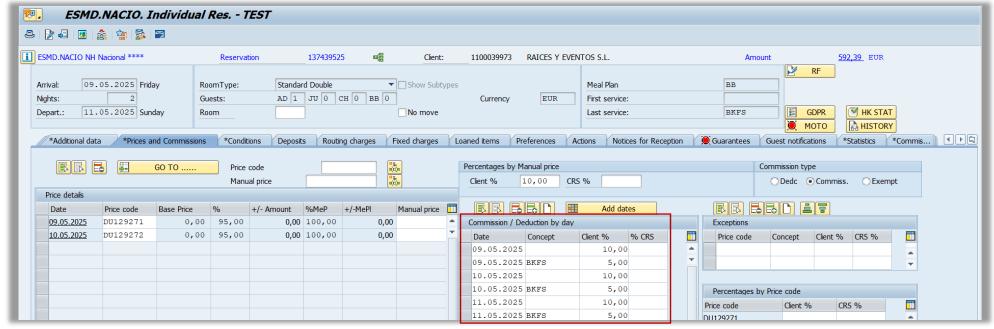
